In Alberta, if you are involved in direct selling in a place other than your place of business, then you are required to hold an Alberta Direct Selling Business Licence, or be subject to enforcement action. Movers need to be aware that this includes soliciting, negotiating, quoting for services or concluding a contract in person in a client's home. 

Canada overseas shipping news

CAM's International Committee met on April 20th and discussed two items that have an effect on household goods coming into and leaving Canada.

First, anyone involved in the overseas shipping of household goods in Canada is urged to review recent amendments to the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) convention concerning mandatory container weight verification requirements, or Verified Gross Mass (VGM), taking effect on July 1, 2016.



CAM President is stepping down

Paul Leader has advised that he will be stepping down as CAM President on December 31, 2016. CAM has established a succession committee to find a suitable candidate to replace Paul. The committee has defined the role to be a part-time position in which the successful candidate would be the representative of the Association to the Canadian moving industry, consumers, media, government and non-government agencies, as well as moving associations around the world. The committee is looking for a candidate who will have a track record of leadership in a moving-industry position. He or she will have demonstrated skills in both written and oral communications, organizing diverse groups, government relations and consensus building. The candidate must have a reasonable level of proficiency in computer operations. The successful candidate would assume the role on November 1, 2016 which would be the beginning of a two-month transition period. Interested parties may submit an application to the national office. All applications will be held in confidence with only CAM staff and members of the committee knowing the name of the applicant.

CAM members provide aid to Alberta

The wildfires continue to burn in Alberta and have spread into Saskatchewan. The loss and devastation in these provinces is tremendous. The fires have now consumed almost 600,000 hectares in Alberta alone. Entire communities remain evacuated, although the Alberta Government just announced a conditional, phased re-entry plan for residents to return to Fort McMurray beginning on June 1.

We're hearing some amazing stories about how CAM members are contributing to relief efforts. For example, **Domestic Moving & Storage** in Newfoundland & Labrador offered free shipping of care packages to evacuees in Alberta from their families in NL. **Atlas Van Lines (Canada) Ltd.** announced that many of their agents across Canada would act as drop off centres for donations to Fort McMurray and Atlas would transport the donations to the Edmonton Emergency Relief Centre. So far, they've collected and delivered four trailer loads of donations with more to go. As well, the International Association of Movers' partner, the **American Logistics Aid Network (ALAN)**, is actively helping to provide disaster relief. 

In it, Bradley expressed concern about the impact of these comments on the morale of truck drivers especially at a time when the industry is facing a driver shortage. BRAND HIJACKINGS BY ROGUE MOVERS

There's a new scam in the marketplace and it's presenting a terrible threat to consumers and reputable moving businesses - it's brand hijacking. Criminal enterprises are creating ads that include reputable brands but with their own contact information. They are also hacking into Google accounts and redirecting prospective customers to their own organizations. Consumers are being led to believe they are getting quotes and booking their movers with credible brands when in fact they are all rogue movers who have no equipment or trucks. The problem is expanding across national Van Lines and other moving companies. Members are urged to Google their own companies and check any links to ensure that there's not been a trademark violation. If you find a violation, advise Google's Trademarks team and your anti-fraud centre immediately. CAM has advised various Canadian consumer protection agencies about this fraud and there is some action being taken by these authorities. We'll keep you advised of developments.

Mover fined in BC

Consumer Protection BC just issued a press release about a \$7,500 fine they levied against Canadian mover Canadian Van Lines aka Coronation Van Lines for deceptive business practices. According to Tatiana Chabeaux-Smith, spokesperson for Consumer Protection BC, "not only was this company knowingly - and repeatedly - making false pickup and delivery promises to customers, but it also refused to issue required refunds, used non-compliant contracts, misrepresented its business location and failed to provide our inspector with required information." Ontario releases report on HHG moving industry

In 2014 the **Ontario Ministry of Government and Consumer Services** commissioned a review of the household goods moving industry in Ontario as part of its effort "to ensure stronger consumer protection in the marketplace regarding the household moving industry". The Ministry's *Final Report: Ontario's Household Moving Industry, May 2015* which was prepared by Prism Economics and Analysis represents the findings of a literature review, surveys, Statistics Canada data and information collected from other industry stakeholders including CAM. Their findings comment on the size of the industry and vulnerability of consumers at the hands of illegitimate movers. The full report is now available for your review.

CBSA news for sufferance warehouse operators

The **Canada Border Services Agency** has issued a communiqué concerning e-Manifest Notices and the Deconsolidation Notice. All freight forwarders are now required to transmit house bill data to CBSA electronically. This mandatory requirement took effect on November 7, 2016. Non-monetary penalties may be applied starting January 11, 2017 and monetary penalties may be applied starting July 12, 2017. If you are engaged in freight-forwarding, you must be compliant with these new regulations by the specified time period. We recommend contacting your EDI service-provider for compliance solutions. Read more.

Customs clearance into the UK update

Last month, we informed you about the new process for clearing household goods and personal effects into the UK that will take effect from January 1st, 2017. The **British Association of Removers** just provided CAM with an update that says the old paper method will be accepted during a period of transition until March 31, 2017.
